## ART INSTITUTES BEGIN JUNE 21 AT THE WORCESTER ART MUSEUM

**(WORCESTER, Mass., May 28, 2010)** – Get an art-making crash course while building your artistic talents in Worcester Art Museum’s art institutes for adults. These popular, short-term art programs offer an alternative to the museum’s traditional, seven-week class schedule. Reserve your seat now – the summer season of art institutes starts on Monday, June 21.

In the WAM studios, students will observe a live model to capture the human form in charcoal or clay. Other classes will explore the effects of color and light through paintings, colored pencils, and photography. During off-campus sites, students in *Moleskin Magic – Traveling Sketchbook* will meet at local coffee shops, Worcester’s Union Station, as well as the museum to people-watch, sketch and learn to draw from observation.

A daytime institute is offered from June 21 – 24. Late afternoon and evening art institutes are scheduled from July 6 - 30. Costs range from \$80 to \$245.
